- EVENT:** 5km WOMEN 15 Sec interval **CLASSICAL** (J2s first)

- SEEDING:** Racers to be seeded fastest to slowest with J2s first.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be at 2:30 pm in the Stadium. Racers must be present to win the bib draws.
- COACHES MEETING:** 9 am in the hand timing building.
- WAX TESTING:** Wax testing allowed on the course up to 15 minutes before the start. Everyone must ski in the direction of the race course.
- WAXING:** Wax rooms available (for a fee) in the wax building on a first come first serve basis. Email chisholmski@gmail.com to reserve a room.
- COURSE MOVEMENT:** All spectators and coaches are welcome out on the course during race. Skiers must travel in the direction of the race course at all times.
- REGISTRATION:** Entry fee **\$10.00 per athlete**. Two coaches comp passes per team.
